

INFORMATION ON THE DOWNLOAD VERSION OF 'HOW TO PLAY BLUES HARMONICA BY EAR'

You are currently reading a pdf file. You can now buy a downloadable version of my harmonica tutor in this same format for a fraction of the price of a hard copy, sent to you as an email pdf attachment direct to your email address.

FAQ

1. How much does it cost?

USD 6, NZD 8

2. Why is it so much cheaper than the hard copy?

I save on many expenses by sending you an electronic version – the cost of paper, the cost of card (for the title page, reference sheet, and quick guide), the cost of CD and label, the cost of the special plastic sleeve (that houses the reference and guide sheets and the CD), the cost of binding, and most importantly, the cost of ink (I don't use cartridge refills).

3. Do I get the same material?

Yes. You could print off the pdf file I send you and bind it into a hard copy which would be similar to the booklet I post out. The 40 mp3 tracks (which I send to you separately) can easily be made into a CD on your own computer.

4. Is the material downloaded the same quality as the hard-copy booklets?

In order to send you the material electronically as attachments, the files (both visual and sound) have had to be down-sized. The single pdf file containing all visual media is still of high quantity for both computer viewing and for printing. The CD tracks will be sent to you in batches as attachments on separate emails. (Although down-sized, the tracks are still quite large in order not to compromise sound quality and so can't all be sent together as one file.)

5. What if all the emails comprising the complete tutor don't arrive?

Senders are always notified if an email cannot be delivered for any reason – so I will know! I will immediately contact you and discuss making the sound track batches smaller if necessary (a batch size of about 5MB is the usual but it can be made any size to suit a user's internet connection and computer).

6. How do I buy the downloads?

On the Contact page you've just come from, the green text contains particular instructions for the download version. You may still pay by cheque or direct debit if you live in NZ, or, by PayPal if you live elsewhere.
